

## **CDP Scoring Methodology Changes: 2022 to 2023**

CDP Water Security 2023



## 1. Introduction

Developments to our questionnaires and scoring methodologies reflect and drive best practice and improve both data quality and the disclosure experience. In line with CDP's 2021-2025 strategy, developments to the scoring methodology in 2023 reflect CDP's strategic priorities to track organizations transition to align with a 1.5 degree, nature-positive world.

The 2023 Water Security questionnaire contains 9 new questions on plastics and the mapping, management, and impact of plastics for companies and their value chain. This is the first-year questions on plastic pollution are included in the questionnaire, so they will not be scored in 2023.

This document aims to indicate where changes to the scoring of questions have occurred in the 2023 Water Security methodology, and where new questions have been introduced and are being scored. Some questions have modified scoring as a result of the question being modified in 2023, and it is noted where this is the case.

The table below includes a table detailing where the 2023 Water Security Scoring Methodology differs from the 2022 methodology, due to clarifications (no change to scoring criteria), minor/Modified scorings, modifications in the scoring criteria or the addition of new criteria.
