Taking environmental action to build a greener Europe



- What: The European Climate Pact is an EU Commission initiative bringing citizens, companies, and local authorities together to achieve a climate neutral Europe.
- How: European stakeholders join the European Climate Pact by making a pledge to concrete environmental action in a way that can be measured and tracked.
- Through CDP disclosure your organization can fully track progress against your sustainability strategy and showcase your growing environmental leadership on the European Climate Pact website

Why:

- A natural step in disclosure journey: take action and communicate about it;
- Ensure transparent and streamlined pledge reporting through CDP disclosure;
- Minimal additional commitment or reporting burden;
- Opportunities to work with EU stakeholders to help shape a greener Europe

How to pledge through CDP

Synchronize disclosure with your pledge reporting



- Radio button in the Submission page of the ORS
- Consent to have your disclosed environmental actions be showcased on the European Climate Pact website
- ▼ Pledge validation criteria: not all reported information becomes a pledge

What is a pledge in CDP disclosure





Level of Ambition	European Climate Pact pledge	CDP disclosure data
North Star: ambitious actions that contribute to greatly reducing greenhouse gas emissions and, in turn, to meeting the goals of the Paris Agreement. These actions are also consistent with the EU's objective of achieving climate neutrality by 2050.	Have an officially validated science-based emissions reduction targets aligned with a 1.5°C scenario (scope 1+2) in line with the SBTi Criteria and Recommendations E.g. Company x has a target to reduce absolute scope 1+2 emissions 75% by 2025 from a base year of 2015	 Emissions reduction target is fully reported in question 4.1 of the Climate questionnaire, in line with SBTi Criteria and Recommendations for parameters required on 1.5°C aligned targets (i.e. Baseline, boundary, target year, etc.); Target is officially validated by SBTi and public on the SBTi website
Pathway: concrete actions to mitigate a company's environmental impact that contribute to the achievement of their North Star goals	Have a target to increase renewable energy consumption E.g. Company x has a target to procure 80% of electricity from renewable sources by 2030 from a base of 0% renewable electricity consumption in 2015	Target fully reported in question 4.2 – i.e. Base year, target year, figure/% in base and reporting year, % achieved in reporting year, coverage


