

Overview of scoring

Scoring principles




- Independent: Scoring is completed by partner organizations trained by CDP. All scores are subject to rigorous quality assurance checks.
- Comparable: The CDP methodologies are the same across all countries the same key actions need to be demonstrated and same information provided.
- **▼ Transparent**: The full guidance and methodology is available online, alongside webinars and explanations.
- **▼ Wide reaching**: In 2021, over 23,000 final scores were awarded.
- Influential: Public scores are published in the CDP website and reports, inform multiple market indices and are shared directly with investors.

We scored over 23,000 responses across all programmes with 589 of those in Forests. This was a 22% increase in scores from 2020.



The Forests questionnaire

Commodity-driven questionnaire and scoring



- ■Companies receive one score per commodity
- ▼Timber, Palm Oil, Cattle Products, and Soy are scored
- Companies can also respond for Rubber, Cocoa and Coffee, but these commodities will receive no score
- To be scored: companies must select 'Yes, disclosing' to at least one of the scored commodities in question F0.4 and select the stages of the value chain in which they operate.

2022 A-list criteria

Several questions are scored for Leadership (please see Question level scoring criteria for further details) and a minimum threshold of points must be met to achieve the Leadership band.

In order to achieve A List status, companies must ensure several items are included within their response and meet several criteria (assessed for each commodity separately):

- A minimum threshold score of Leadership points must be achieved, as outlined in the Scoring Introduction;
- No significant exclusions reported in questions F0.5/F0.5a:
- In the rationale of the exclusions (F0.5a) companies must provide an indication of the level of significance of each exclusion reported, and a quantitative measure of the commodity usage that each exclusion represents. Companies that fail to provide any kind of rationale or quantitative measure in their explanations will not be eligible for the 2022 Forests A list.
- Exclusions due to recent mergers, acquisitions or divestitures will not be considered as significant exclusions and are exempt from the above criteria. If reporting an exclusion due to recent mergers or acquisitions, include the year in which the acquisition occurred and when the company expects to include the forests-related data in their reporting.
- Demonstrate that a comprehensive and thorough risk assessment of all operations and supply chains has been undertaken: by achieving full Awareness points in question F2.1a;
- Demonstrate action towards deforestation and forest degradation-related commitments:

- Demonstrate action towards deforestation and forest degradationrelated commitments;
- Companies must select 'Yes' in questions F4.6, F6.1, F6.2 and F6.11; 'Yes, we have a documented forest policy that is publicly available' in F4.5; 'Yes, we have a system in place for our no conversion and/or deforestation commitments' in F6.4; and 'Yes, working with direct suppliers' in F6.8 (if applicable);
- Companies must select at least one of the following in column 'Content' in question F4.5a: 'Commitment to eliminate conversion of natural ecosystems', 'Commitment to eliminate deforestation' or 'Commitment to no deforestation, to no planting on peatlands and to no exploitation (NDPE)';
- Companies must select at least one of the following in column 'Criteria' in question F4.6b: 'No conversion of natural ecosystems' or 'Zero gross deforestation / no deforestation' (for Timber products, 'Zero net deforestation' will also be accepted);
- Companies must achieve EITHER full Leadership points in question F6.2a (i.e. at least 90% traceability of commodity volumes to a sufficient point of traceability), OR full Management points in question F6.3 (i.e. at least 70% certification of commodity volumes).

- Requirement to achieve points for question F4.6b, Leadership criterion ii) removed
- New A-list requirements introduced companies must:
 - Have a public no deforestation/conversion commitment,
 - Include commitments to eliminate conversion and/or deforestation in their forest policy,
 - Have EITHER 90% traceability of commodity volumes to a sufficient point of traceability, OR 70% certification of commodity volumes.
